

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adoption of the San Lucy District FY 2000 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-607

1 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council adopted Resolution SL 09-83-99, which permitted**
2 **continuing operations of the District until such time that a comprehensive FY-**
3 **00 budget is adopted by the San Lucy District Council and approved by the**
4 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution 99-506 did approve for the**
6 **San Lucy District to continue operations under their FY-99 Budget; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the District Council has prepared and approved their proposed FY-2000 District**
8 **Budget in the amount of \$2,397,839.49 to cover anticipated cost and expenses**
9 **from October 01, 1999 to September 30, 2000; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District has sufficient funds in the District's Gaming Account to**
11 **provide for the proposed governmental operations in the amount of \$610,901.53**
12 **and P.L. 99-503 funds to provide additional administrative, support, and**
13 **program operations contained in the FY-00 budget, in the amount of**
14 **\$1,738,078.76; and**

15 **WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$29,848.00 will be available from 93-638 Substance Abuse**
16 **Contract to cover expenses related to the District's Drug and Alcohol Project;**
17 **and**

18 **WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$19,011.20 will be available from the Diabetes Program**
19 **to cover expense related to the Diabetes Project; and**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
21 **approves the San Lucy District FY 2000 Budget in the amount of \$2,397,839.49 to**
22 **commence retro active October 01, 1999 and ending September 30, 2000.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that bi-weekly disbursements be wire transferred to Account**
24 **No. 8221861432- Community First, Gila Bend Branch, Gila Bend, Arizona.**

1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the
2 16TH day of NOVEMBER 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
3 2,165.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested
4 in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
5 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the
6 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
7 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


