7	the Environmental Protection Agency for a two year period to educate the
8	O'odham People about household hazardous waste, pollution prevention,

10	WHEREAS, the grant allows for matching funds to be in-kind not actual monies, and the
11	grant does not allow for in-direct cost allocation.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
13	accepts \$40,240.00 for a pollution prevention program and authorizes
14	expenditure of funds in accordance with the grant application scope of work
15	and all policies and procedures set forth by the Council, and that any funds
16	available at end of year one be carried forward to year two.

18	NOVEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2.165.5 FOR; -0-

20	Section 1 <u>(f)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
21	Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
22	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
23	June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
