

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the acceptance of a Pollution Program Grant from the EPA)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-609

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve the submittal, and**
2 **acceptance of the Pollution Prevention Grant requesting \$99,676.00 by**
3 **Resolution No. 98-146, for a pollution prevention program and if successful the**
4 **authority to accept and to spend such funds in accordance with the grant**
5 **application scope of work and all policies and procedures set; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program has received a grant of \$40,240.00 from**
7 **the Environmental Protection Agency for a two year period to educate the**
8 **O'odham People about household hazardous waste, pollution prevention,**
9 **recycling and proper disposal and clean-up; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the grant allows for matching funds to be in-kind not actual monies, and the**
11 **grant does not allow for in-direct cost allocation.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
13 **accepts \$40,240.00 for a pollution prevention program and authorizes**
14 **expenditure of funds in accordance with the grant application scope of work**
15 **and all policies and procedures set forth by the Council, and that any funds**
16 **available at end of year one be carried forward to year two.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 16TH, day of**
18 **NOVEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
19 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
20 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
21 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
22 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
23 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
