

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services-Division of
Psychological Services - FY 2000 TODHS SMI Program to utilize Third Party
Billing Revenues Funds)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-615

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently operating the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Psychological Services Treatment Program for the Seriously Mentally Ill Tas**
3 **Tonlik Ki Day Program through a tribal subsidy and I.H.S. grant utilizing**
4 **carryover monies; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve the FY99 TODHS-Division**
6 **of Psychological Services - Revenue Fund Budget to cover the SMI Day Program**
7 **for the month of September 1999 through Resolution 99-500; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the program has prepared the FY 2000 SMI budget to use projected funds**
9 **generated through third party billing to cover the personnel and operational**
10 **expenses for the fiscal year (October 01, 1999 to September 30, 2000) in the**
11 **amount of \$144,017.51.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

- 13 **1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the FY 2000**
14 **TODHS Special Revenues Fund Budget at \$144,017.51 to cover personnel and**
15 **operational expenses effective October 01, 1999 to September 30, 2000.**
- 16 **2. That the Department of Human Services requests waiver on Indirect Costs**
17 **for this Special Revenue budget to cover the personnel and operational**
18 **expenditures for the SMI Day Program.**
- 19 **3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairman, Vice**
20 **Chairman and any designated Officer are hereby authorized to negotiate**
21 **and execute the proposal.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH day of**
23 **NOVEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,037.4 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 128.1 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
25 **Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**
26 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the**
27 **Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant**
28 **to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


