6		Environmental Protection Agency under the Urban Pesticide Initiative Program
7		and other grant programs; and
8	WHEREAS,	the U.S. Environmental Protection agency (EPA), Region IX has announced that
9		the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded \$40,000.00 to implement an Urban
10		Pesticide Initiative Program; and
11	WHEREAS,	in order to supplement the Pesticide Program, the Tohono O'odham Nation has
12	٠	prepared an application to EPA, Region IX Cross Media Division for the
13		Cooperative Agreement Funds to implement an Urban Pesticide Initiative; and
14	WHEREAS,	the establishment of an Urban Pesticide Initiative Program will allow the Nation
15		to address any pesticide related concerns and to assist in the preservation of the
16		environment for the well being of human health; and
17	WHEREAS,	under the Urban Pesticide Initiative Program the Pesticide/Environmental
18		Specialist will work on awareness and educate the Nation on pesticide
19		applications which occurs at the farms and by commercial applicators within
20		community homes, schools and business entities.
21	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
22		approves the Budget for \$40,000.00 from the Environmental Protection Agency
23		to implement the Urban Pesticide Initiative Program.
24	BE IT FUR	THER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the
25		Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any
26		designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
