

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Equal Employment Opportunity Commission FY - 2000 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-637

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office**
2 **since 1978 and has successfully met the needs of the Tohono O'odham; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office**
4 **has been supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is essential to**
6 **eradicate employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the**
7 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the contract between the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the**
9 **Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office has been approved by the**
10 **Office of the Chairman in the amount of \$25,000.00.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that**
12 **it hereby approves the continued supplemental funding for the Tribal**
13 **Employment Rights Office from the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission**
14 **in the amount of \$25,000.00.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall commence on October 01,**
16 **1999 through September 30, 2000.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Tohono**
18 **O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are**
19 **hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that**
20 **any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be**
21 **submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 6TH,**
24 **day of DECEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,777.0**
25 **FOR; 222.6 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 165.9 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested**
26 **in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
27 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
28 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**
29 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
