

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) Education  
Contract for Funding in the amount of \$10,000)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-641**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve the submittal and**  
2 **acceptance of the EQIP Education Contract in the amount of \$10,000.00 by**  
3 **Resolution No. 98-232, for an education plan; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Natural Resources Department promotes active**  
5 **management of range resources through the education of land users about**  
6 **sound ecological stewardship of the land; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Soil Water Conservation District (SWCD) works under the Natural Resources**  
8 **Department in cooperation with the USDA/Natural Resources Conservation**  
9 **Service (NRCS); and**

10 **WHEREAS, it is a priority of this program to provide conservation education and**  
11 **conservation planning assistance on rangelands to help insure an integrated**  
12 **approach to natural resource management; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the NRCS agrees to provide \$10,000 under 1996 Farm Bill, Environmental Quality**  
14 **Incentives Program, (EQIP) towards the cost of an approved education plan to be**  
15 **carried out by the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 17 **1. Hereby accepts \$10,000 for an Environmental Quality Incentives Program and**  
18 **authorizes expenditure of funds in accordance with the education plan.**
- 19 **2. The Chairman is authorized to enter into any contracts or agreements**  
20 **required to perform this work.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup>**  
23 **Day of DECEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,920.55**  
24 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; 79.05 NOT VOTING; and 165.9 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested**  
25 **in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
26 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
27 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**  
28 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


