10	b	eneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation to accommodate the contractor, and
11	h	as developed a use agreement which incorporates the appropriate legal
12	re	equirements.
13	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that use of
14	tl	he Nation's water delivery pipeline for transmission of construction water is an
15	a	cceptable use, provided that all liabilities, risks, and repair costs are assumed
16	ь	y the contractor, as stipulated in the attached Pipeline Indemnity and Use
17	A	greement.

19	a	ttached Pipeline Indemnity and Use Agreement and authorizes the Chairman
20	o	f the Nation to execute the agreement on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation.
