

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the submission of Manuscript entitled, "Control of a Hepatitis A**  
**Outbreak in An American Indian Population using Hepatitis A Vaccine"**  
**by Doug Thoroughman)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-659**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is the governing body of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**  
2 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the health and care of the children of the**  
3 **Nation as a priority of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 97-107 in support of the vaccination**  
5 **campaign before proceeding with the campaign; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the campaign targeted all children attending pre-school through eighth grade,**  
7 **reservation wide. The campaign involved Indian Health Service, tribal, county,**  
8 **state and the U.S. Air Force health personnel combined efforts to plan, initiate and**  
9 **execute a campaign on the reservation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, Mr. Doug Thoroughman, Center for the Health Promotion Department of**  
11 **Pediatrics, Medicine and Family/Community, University of New Mexico has written**  
12 **a manuscript titled, " Control of a Hepatitis A Outbreak in an American Indian**  
13 **Population using Hepatitis A Vaccine" to submit to the American Journal of Public**  
14 **Health.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
16 **approves and endorses the submittal of the manuscript to the American Journal**  
17 **of Public Health for consideration of publication.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the data collected will remain sole proprietorship of the Tohono**  
19 **O'odham Nation.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup>,**  
21 **day of DECEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,094.7 FOR;**  
22 **293.4 AGAINST; 605.6 NOT VOTING; and 171.8 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
23 **Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**  
24 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
25 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
26 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
