SUBJECT: Extension of Comment Deadline for Border Patrol Linear Ground Detection
System and Autonomous Surveillance Tower Proposals

The Domestic Affairs Committee held public hearings for Nation's members on November 12 and 26, 2025 to learn and ask Border Patrol questions about their proposal to deploy a Linear Ground Detection System ("LGDS") and Autonomous Surveillance Towers at the Nation's border with Mexico and along the Traditional Northern Road. Members of the Nation were encouraged to attend the public hearing, voice their opinions, and submit any written comments by December 19, 2025.
