The Domestic Affairs Committee is notifying the public of a change in location for the November 26, 2025 public hearing on the Border Patrol Linear Ground Detection System and Automated Surveillance Tower Proposals:

• November 26, 2025 at 9:00 AM at the Hikiwan Recreation Center, Hikiwan District (lunch provided)

The United States Border Patrol Tucson Sector is proposing to deploy a Linear Ground Detection System ("LGDS") and Automated Surveillance Towers at the Nation's border with Mexico and along the Traditional Northern Road. According to Border Patrol, the LGDS is an in-ground detection and identification system that would increase Border Patrol's awareness of illegal entries into the United States. The Automated Surveillance Towers would have overlapping camera coverage that would view and record activity at or near the length of the border. These towers would be in addition to the existing Integrated Fixed Tower System.
