

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Juan Zazueta to the TERO Commission for a Term Expiring April 30, 2013)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-426

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "provide for,**
2 **appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers of**
3 **committees, boards, officers and agents" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
4 **Article VI, Section 1(b)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, in 1985, the Papago Council enacted the Papago Employment Rights Ordinance ("TERO**
6 **Ordinance"), thereby establishing the Papago Employment Rights Commission (a.k.a.,**
7 **"TERO Commission") and vesting the Council with the power to select and appoint**
8 **TERO commissioners (TERO Ordinance, Ordinance No. 01-85, Section 6(B)(2)); and**

9 **WHEREAS, Section 6(C) of the TERO Ordinance provides that "[c]ommissioners shall be appointed**
10 **for terms of three years, or until their successors are appointed and qualified,**
11 **provided, however, that appointments to the Commission shall be made in such a way**
12 **and for such terms that their terms shall be staggered so that the terms of office of**
13 **only two Commissioners will end in any single year"; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Timothy Toro was appointed to the TERO Commission with a term ending April 30,**
15 **2010 and continues to serve until his successor is appointed and qualified (Resolution**
16 **No. 09-206); and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has been delegated authority to "review and**
18 **recommend action by the Legislative Council on appointments of . . . TERO**
19 **Commissioners" (Plan of Operation for the Domestic Affairs Committee, Article III.D.**
20 **as adopted by Legislative Order No. 01-431); and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has recommended that Juan Zazueta be appointed**
22 **to a term ending April 30, 2013 or until his successor is appointed and qualified.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
24 **appoints Juan Zazueta to the TERO Commission commencing on the effective date of**
25 **this resolution and ending April 30, 2013 or until his successor is appointed and**
26 **qualified.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH Day**
28 **of SEPTEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**


