9	WHEREAS.	the proposed Rosemont Copper Project needs power for construction and operation

11	WHEREAS.	Tucson Electric Power has proposed to construct a 138kV transmission line to provide
12		the proposed Rosemont Copper Project with 118 MW of power; and
13	WHEREAS.	in order to construct the transmission line, Tucson Electric Power must first obtain
14	,	a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility from the Arizona Power Plant and
15		Transmission Line Siting Committee, a Committee of the Arizona Corporation

17	WHEREAS.	Tucson Electric Power has applied for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility as
