(Approval of Carry Forward Funds of the US Department of Homeland Security, FEMA,
2009 State Homeland Security Program – Tribal #2009-SS-T9-0073 for \$82,565.79)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-583

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management**
2 **Agency (FEMA) has distributed grants states to fund for purchases that provide public**
3 **safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, eligible Indian tribes have been designated to receive direct funding from the**
5 **Department of Homeland Security - FEMA established from the 9-11**
6 **Recommendations Act; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted an application for FY2009 to FEMA for**
8 **direct funding; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant from the Department of Homeland**
10 **Security, FEMA in the amount of \$194,000.00 as part of the 2009 State Homeland**
11 **Security Program - Tribal to help strengthen the Nation against risks associated with**
12 **potential terrorist attacks and natural disasters; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the 2009 State Homeland Security Program – Tribal Grant No. 2009-SS-T9-0073 carry**
14 **forward in the amount of \$82,565.79 has been reviewed by the Office of Grants &**
15 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**
16 **Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative**
17 **Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves carry**
19 **forward funds of the 2009 State Homeland Security Program – Tribal No. 2009-SS-T9-**
20 **0073 in the amount of \$82,565.79 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation General Fund.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes**
23 **the Office of Emergency Management to expend funds from the FEMA 2009 State**
24 **Homeland Security Program – Tribal in accordance with the terms of the grant award**
25 **period of 08/01/09 to 07/31/2012 and further waives the three percent indirect costs**
26 **to administer this grant.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
28 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**
29 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
30 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
