

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Arizona Department of Homeland Security, 2011 Homeland Security Grant Program, Grant Award #888415-01 for \$35,768.00)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-584

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants to**
2 **counties, through their respective states, to fund equipment purchases and training**
3 **by departments that provide public safety services within their respective**
4 **jurisdictions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive funds through the respective state,**
6 **requiring tribes to sign a Letter of Offer and Acceptance; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated a Letter of Offer and Acceptance with the**
8 **State of Arizona which was approved in the form attached hereto by the Tohono**
9 **O'odham Legislative Council through Resolution 09-256 signed by the Chairman; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded a grant from the Arizona Department**
11 **of Homeland Security in the amount of \$35,768.00 as from the 2011 State Homeland**
12 **Security Program Grant No. 888415-01 for the Homeland Security Initiative Planning**
13 **Position for the Office of Emergency Management; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the 2011 State Homeland Security Program Grant No. 888415-01 award of \$35,768.00**
15 **has been reviewed by the Office Grants & Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs**
16 **Committee and Budget & Finance Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of**
17 **the grant award by the Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
19 **accepts the grant award of \$35,768.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono**
20 **O'odham Nation General Fund for the Homeland Security Initiative Planning needed**
21 **for enhancing the Tohono O'odham Nation, Office of Emergency Management and**
22 **further waives any additional indirect costs to administer this grant.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation, Office of Emergency Management is**
24 **authorized to expend funds from this grant in the amount of \$35,768.00 in accordance**
25 **with the terms of the 2011 State Homeland Security Program Grant No. 888415-01 from**
26 **Oct. 1, 2011 to May 29, 2012.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
28 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**
29 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
30 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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


