13		increase in the operating cost would be very beneficial as the awareness of Family
14		Violence Prevention has increased therefore increasing the need to provide more
15		service and support; and
16	WHEREAS,	Eliminating the Family Resource Specialist position will result in a total decrease of
17		\$41,991.49 from line items 6000 Salaries and 6200 Fringe; therefore allowing the
18		following modifications to program line items; and
19	WHEREAS,	a total increase in the amount of \$33,990.42 made to line items 6500 Tuition and
20		Registration, 7300 Advertisement, 7000 Supplies-Office, 7005 Supplies-Other, 7010
21		Program Supplies, 7355 Professional Services, 7340 Public Relations, 7060 Food, 7665
22		Client Support, and a total decrease of \$1,787.00 made to line items 6530 Travel
23		Expense, 7110 Communications, and 9000 Indirect Cost Charges adjusts the total
24		amount of the budget to \$123,892.00 for Fiscal Year 2012; and
25	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee
26		of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and
