

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval and Acceptance of the Arizona Department of Transportation, Planning Assistance for Rural Areas "School Bus Routes Transportation Study")**

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-022**

1 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation ("ADOT") offers grants for Planning**  
2 **Assistance for Rural Areas ("PARA"); and**

3 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to apply for "PARA" grants; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed the Resolution Number 99-059,**  
5 **which details the procedure for Executive Branch Departments to apply for grants;**  
6 **and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation followed the procedure in Resolution Number 99-059**  
8 **and was subsequently approved as a grant recipient for a "PARA" School Bus Routes**  
9 **Transportation Study ("the Study"); and**

10 **WHEREAS, Jacobs Engineering was awarded the bid as the engineering company to complete the**  
11 **study; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department met with all eleven districts**  
13 **and all school districts on numerous occasions to assist Jacobs Engineering in**  
14 **compiling an inventory of school bus routes and the condition of those routes and bus**  
15 **stops; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department met with and accepted public**  
17 **comments from all eleven districts to include as part of "the Study"; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department has met with the Legislative Commerce Committee to**  
19 **review the Planning Assistance for Rural Areas "School Bus Route Transportation**  
20 **Study" and the Legislative Commerce Committee recommends approval by the**  
21 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**  
23 **and approves the Arizona Department of Transportation Planning Assistance for**  
24 **Rural Areas "School Bus Routes Transportation Study" as prepared by Jacobs**  
25 **Engineering.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
27 **of JANUARY, 2012 a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**  
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
30 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
32 **Stat. 984).**
