

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving and acceptance of the US Department of Homeland Security, FEMA, FY2010
Emergency Operations Center Grant Program, Grant No.2010-EO-MX-0013 for \$500,000.00)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-027

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency**
2 **Management Agency (FEMA) has distributed grants to states to fund for purchases**
3 **that provide public safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted an application in FY2010 to FEMA for**
5 **direct funding under the Emergency Operations Center (EOC)Grant Program; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded a grant from the DHS - FEMA in the**
7 **amount of \$500,000.00 as part of the FY2010 Emergency Operations Center Grant**
8 **Program for emergency management and preparedness capabilities by supporting**
9 **flexible, sustainable, secure strategically located, and fully intraoperative EOC's with**
10 **a focus on addressing identified deficiencies and needs; and**

11 **WHEREAS, FY2010 Emergency Operations Center Grant Program No. 2010-EO-MX-0013 awarded**
12 **funds of \$500,000.00 has been reviewed by the Office of Grants & Contracts, Executive**
13 **Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee, of which all**
14 **recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative Council.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and**
16 **approves the FY2010 EOC Grant Program No. 2010-EO-MX-0013 in the amount of**
17 **\$500,000.00 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham Nation General**
18 **Fund.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and authorizes**
20 **the Office of Emergency Management to expend funds from the FY2010 EOC Grant**
21 **Program in accordance with the terms of the grant for the Budget period of 06/01/10**
22 **to 05/31/2013.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
24 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
25 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
26 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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
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1 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**



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
