14	WHEREAS,	the FY2012 Budget Account 100-12-5001 was appropriately changed to reflect no
15		monetary funding level changes but only changes within the appropriate Budget
16		Narrative to reflect the twenty-five percent (25%) cost share match for the grant; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Modification #1 of the Police Department's FY2012 Budget Account #100-12-5001
18		has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee
19		and Budget & Finance Committee, of which all recommend acceptance of the budget
20		amendment by the Legislative Council.
21	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and
22		accepts the Budget Modification #1 of the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department
23		FY2012 Budget Account # 100-12-5001 to reflect no monetary change in the funding
24		level and reflect the twenty-five percent (25%) cost share match within the Budget
25		Narrative of the appropriate line item for the FY2010 EOC Grant Program award.
