

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2012 Department of Justice Recovery Act Combating Rural
Crime in the amount of \$328,211.56)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-029

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department was awarded the Department of**
2 **Justice Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2009 Recovery Act**
3 **(BJA - Rural Law Enforcement) grant number 2009-SD-B9-0118 in the amount of**
4 **\$394,724.00 for a two year period beginning August 1, 2009 through July 31, 2011; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the grant was accepted and approved by full TOLC under resolution No. 10-043; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the grant expired on July 31, 2011 which the TONPD requested an extension to the**
7 **grant for a one year period and was awarded the extension from August 1, 2009**
8 **through July 31, 2012; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has created an FY 2012 budget in the amount of \$328,211.56 which has**
10 **been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants & Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic**
11 **Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee, of all which recommend**
12 **acceptance by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
14 **accepts approves and authorizes the FY 2012 budget for the Department of Justice,**
15 **Office of Justice Program, Bureau of Justice Programs FY 2009 Recovery Act (BJA -**
16 **Rural Law Enforcement) in the amount of \$328,211.56.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant expired on July 31, 2011 however a one year extension**
18 **was approved to July 31, 2012.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**
20 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
21 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall**
22 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
24 **of JANUARY, 2012 a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Section 1 (~~f~~) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
29 **Stat. 984).**
