## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving Nation's Comments on PEPFAR Title VI Funding)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-031

1	WHEREAS, In July 2008 the United States enacted a law known as PEPFAK (President's Emergency
2	Plan for AIDS Relief), Public Law 110-293, which included a Title VI which authorized
3	a special fund for Indian safety and health called the Emergency Fund for Indian
4	Safety and Health; and
5	WHEREAS, the \$2 billion authorized for this fund was reduced by Congress in a later amendment
6	to \$1.6 billion, of which approximately \$602 million was directed to the Department
7	of the Interior to implement water supply or delivery infrastructure requirements for
8	Indian water settlements; and
9	WHEREAS, Title VI of the PEPFAR law directed that the Department of the Interior would hold
10	tribal consultations to determine how the funds would be allocated among Indian
11	tribes; and
12	WHEREAS, two members of the Water Resources Committee attended a tribal consultation on
13	December 9, 2011, in Albuquerque, New Mexico on PEPFAR Title VI funding; and
14	WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee has drafted comments to Title VI of the PEPFAR law
15	which are due at the Department of the Interior on or before January 13, 2012; and
16	WHEREAS, in accordance with the Government Comment Guidelines, Title 1 T.O.C. Chapter 3, the
17	Water Resources Committee has submitted the attached comments for approval by
18	the Legislative Council.
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20	Nation's comments to Title VI of the PEPFAR law substantially in the form attached
21	hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to sign the letter and deliver the
22	comments to the Department of the Interior.
