

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing and Appropriating \$2,500.00 from the Tohono O'odham Nation's FY 2012
Surplus Funds to the National Indian Health Board for the *Amici Curiae* Brief in
***States of Florida, et al. v. Department of Health and Human Services, et al.*)**

RESOLUTION NO. 12-037

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the authority to "manage any funds within the
2 exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation. . ." and to allow expenditures of
3 Nation's funds "pursuant to appropriations or budgets authorized under resolutions
4 or in accordance with ordinances of the Tohono O'odham Council. . ." (Constitution,
5 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

6 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 12-020, the Legislative Council authorized participation as an
7 *amicus* in the National Indian Health Board's *amici curiae* brief in *States of Florida,*
8 *et al. v. Department of Health and Human Services, et al.*; and

9 WHEREAS, in addition to inviting tribes to participate as *amici*, the National Indian Health Board
10 also requested financial contributions to assist with the costs of preparing and filing
11 an *amici curiae* brief; and

12 WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interests to contribute to the cost of the National Indian Health
13 Board's *amici curiae* brief in *States of Florida, et al. v. Department of Health and*
14 *Human Services, et al.*; and

15 WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee
16 recommend authorizing and appropriating \$2,500.00 from the Nation's FY 2012
17 surplus funds to the National Indian Health Board for the *amici curiae* brief.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and
19 appropriates \$2,500.00 from the Nation's FY 2012 surplus funds to the National Indian
20 Health Board for the *amici curiae* brief in *States of Florida, et al. v. Department of*
21 *Health and Human Services, et al.*

22 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and directs the
23 Nation's Treasurer to provide the National Indian Health Board with the Nation's
24 \$2,500.00 contribution.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day
26 of JANUARY, 2012 a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60; FOR -0-
27 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
28 Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
29 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
30 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
31 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




