1	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2		Nation, the Legislative Council is vested with the power to manage the Nation's fund
3		"and to appropriate these funds for the benefit of the Nation and its members"; and
4	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council has established a formula for distributing its net gaming
5		revenues, including a percentage that has been designated as the "District Allocation"
6		to fund fiscal year budgets for each of the Nation's eleven Districts (26 Tohono
7		O'odham Code, Chapter 1, Article 3, Section 1301); and
8	WHEREAS,	the District Allocation "shall be apportioned to the separate District accounts in
9		accordance with the allocation formula established by the Legislative Council and
10		shall be made available for expenditure subject to"
11		(1) District budgets approved in accordance with the Nation's Constitution and;
12		Section 302 of Ordinance No. 93-01, Ordinance for the Regulation of Gaming
13		Activities Within the Tohono O'odham Nation (Gaming Ordinance"), and
14		$(2) \hbox{``actual expenditures which have been budgeted for and expended in compliance}$
15		with" the Constitution and Gaming Ordinance, and
16		(3) an annual audit of each District's books of accounts and activities, and
17		(4) the establishment and maintenance of a system of internal controls by the
18		District (26 Tohono O'odham Code Section 1304); and
19	WHEREAS,	pursuant to the Gaming Ordinance, the Tohono O'odham Nation-State of Arizona
20		Gaming Compact, and the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, the Nation must ensure that
21		net gaming revenues, including revenues allocated to the Districts, are used
22		exclusively for one or more of the following purposes; (1) to fund government
23		operations or programs of the Nation or Districts; (2) to provide for the general welfare
24		of the Nation and its members; (3) to promote the Nation's economic development; (4)
25		to benefit charitable organizations providing services benefitting the Nation or its
26		members; (5) to help fund operations of local government agencies; (6) to make per
27		capita payments to enrolled members of the Nation, subject to compliance with all
28		applicable laws of the United States and the Nation (Gaining Ordinance, Section 302;
29		Compact, Section 16(d); 25 U.S.C. § 2710(b)(2)(B)); and
30	WHEREAS,	in 2004, it was clear that the Hickiwan District did not have control over the

management of its finances, did not have appropriate internal controls, and did not

have the professional expertise to maintain its books and records in accordance with

 generally accepted accounting principles and therefore could not fully comply with the requirements of 26 Tohono O'odham Code Section 1304 to (1) undergo an annual audit of its books of accounts and activities and (2) maintain a system of internal controls; and

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WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council met in Special Session on July 8, 2004 to discuss the financial situation of the Hickiwan District and pursuant to Hickiwan District Resolution No. 07-04-04 approved the following actions:

(1) transferred "the financial management function of the Hickiwan District, and control of all Hickiwan District funds, to the Tohono O'odham Nation, for an indeterminate period," and

(2) authorized and directed "the Nation's Accounting Department and the Office of the Chairwoman to open accounts necessary to manage the District's finances and to provide technical assistance to the Hickiwan District in order to comply with the financial policies, procedures, and laws of the Nation;" and

WHEREAS, the Tohono Legislative Council met on July 20, 2004 and by Legislative Council Resolution Nos. 04-327 and 04-328 (i) approved the transfer of the financial management function of the Hickiwan District to the Nation for an indeterminate period, (ii) authorized and directed the Nation's Accounting Department and the Office of the Chairwoman to provide technical assistance to the District, (iii) authorized the Office of the Treasurer to communicate with financial institutions at which the District had accounts, and (iv) authorized and appointed a financial team to handle matters associated with the District's financial situations; and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2004, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council considered the need to open a separate interest bearing account for the purpose of depositing investment funds held by the District and enacted Resolution NO. 04-451 to permit such an account to be opened and to transfer the District's investment funds to that account; and

WHEREAS, since 2004, the Nation's Executive Branch has worked with the Hickiwan District to improve financial management of District funds; and

WHEREAS, the District has made substantial efforts to comply with the requirements of Resolution No. 95-397 as codified at 26 T.O.C. Sections 1302-1306 and specifically including the adoption and approval of District budgets, expenditures in accordance with approved budgets, and annual audit and establishment and maintenance of a system of internal controls; and

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32 33 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council, by Resolution No. HDC-12-008, has requested that the Nation return financial management functions to the District and has documented the actions it has taken to prepare for the return of financial management functions, including: (i) the development and adoption of a Fiscal Management Policy Manual, reviewed by the Nation's Treasurer and amended on September 11, 2011 in accordance with the Treasurer's recommendations, (ii) the engagement of an outside accountant to set up and maintain an electronic bookkeeping system for the District, to provide backup to the District and to provide reconciliation and monthly adjustments to the general ledger, and (iii) in accordance with the Fiscal Management Policy Manual, the identification of the roles and responsibilities of each member of the District's Financial Team (the Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer, Secretary and Accountant) to provide internal controls, checks and balances within the District; and WHEREAS, the Independent auditor, REDW, has audited the financial statements of the governmental activities and major fund of the Hickiwan District, as of and for the year ended September 30, 2009 and REDW is of the opinion that "the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the governmental activities and major fund of the District as of September 30, 2009, and the changes in financial position thereof for the year then ended in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America" (emphasis added); and WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee met with the Hickiwan District on January 30, 2012, reviewed the package of materials and the draft resolution seeking return of financial management and control of District finances to the District, suggested revisions to the
