

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing
Services Tribal Resource Grant Program Extension to July 31, 2012 and
approving the attached FY 2012 Budget for \$25,231.20)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-076

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) applied for and was awarded**
2 **the Department of Justice of Community Oriented Policing Services Tribal Resource**
3 **Grant Program (TRGP) Equipment and Training Grant in the amount of \$400,000.00**
4 **under TOLC Resolution No. 09-590; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the TRGP grant was effective August 1, 2009 through July 31, 2011 and has since**
6 **expired; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the TONPD applied for and was awarded a grant extension for one year from July 31,**
8 **2011 to July 31, 2012; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the grant has remaining funds of \$25,231.20 which TONPD has created a FY 2012**
10 **budget with line item 7006 Computer Cost; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the grant does not allow for Indirect Cost; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the attached FY 2012 budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants &**
13 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance**
14 **Committee of the Legislative Council, which all recommend approval and acceptance.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
16 **approves the Grant Extension for the Department of Justice Office of Community**
17 **Oriented Policing Services Tribal Resource Grant Program to July 31, 2012.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
19 **approves and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached FY 2012**
20 **Budget in the amount of \$25,231.20 with line item 7006 Computer Cost, and no Indirect**
21 **Costs.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**
23 **the Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
24 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
25 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day**
27 **of MARCH, 2012 a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
29 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
32 **Stat. 984).**


