10	sensitive information owned by the Nation; and
11	WHEREAS,either party may terminate the MOU upon (30) days prior written notice to the other
12	party of its intent to terminate access to its law enforcement information; and
13	WHEREAS, the attached MOU has been reviewed by the Domestic Affairs Committee which
14	recommends Legislative Council approval.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
16	the MOU with the City of Tucson (Police Department), substantially in the form
17	attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute it.
