9		for FY11 and the One Stop Division request to amend the FY 12 Master 477 Budget to

18		7340 Public Relations, 7060 Food, 7680 Special Activities and 7500 Major Capital
19		Equipment; and
20	WHEREAS,	the total FY12 budget will increase from \$1,062,190.41 to \$1,802,712.19 and includes
21		the IDC increase from \$136,479.54 to \$183,233.82; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee
23		of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and
24		adoption.
25	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
26		approve and authorize amendment #1 of the FY 2012 Master 477 Budget for the
27		Education Department - One Stop Division effective October 1, 2011 to September 30,
28		2012 in the amount of \$1,802,712.19 by increasing the budget from \$1,062,190.41 and
29		includes the increased IDC amount from \$136,479.54 to \$183,233.82 also allowing to
30		increase and create new line items in operational expense.
