## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Designating Nation's Representatives in Good Faith Settlement Talks)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-118

1	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult, negotiate and conclude
2	agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State
3	and local governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, o
4	political subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters within
5	the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6	Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS, the Nation is currently engaged in litigation in the United States District Court for the
8	District of Arizona in a matter captioned <i>State of Arizona et al. v. Tohono O'odhan</i>
9	Nation, 11-cv-00296-DGC (the "Litigation"); and
10	WHEREAS, the United States District Court has ordered that the parties and their counsel mee
11	in person and engage in good faith settlement talks; and
12	WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interest to designate individuals to represent the Nation in
13	good faith settlement talks with the other parties to the Litigation.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
15	designates the Chairperson of the Nation and the Chairpersons of the Tohono
16	O'odham Legislative Council Commerce Committee, Agricultural and Natura
17	Resources Committee, and Budget and Finance Committee, in consultation with
18	counsel, to act as the Nation's representatives in good faith settlement talks as
19	ordered by the United States District Court in the matter captioned State of Arizona
20	et al. v. Tohono O'odham Nation, 11-cv-00296-DGC; provided that no settlemen
21	agreement shall be effective unless and until such agreement is approved by the
22	Legislative Council.
23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12 <sup>TH</sup> Day of <u>APRIL</u> , 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0 AGAINST;-0-NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
