

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health, Youth Suicide Prevention Grant for FY 2012)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-122

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health provides**
2 **substance abuse, mental health, and prevention services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Division of Behavioral Health submitted an application to the U.S. Department of**
4 **Health and Human Services/Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services**
5 **Administration (USDHHS/SAMHSA) for a Youth Suicide Prevention Grant Initiative to**
6 **provide programs to reduce youth suicides and increase wellness due to high**
7 **incidence of youth suicide on the Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Department was notified on August 22, 2011 by Grants and Contracts of the award**
9 **notice from USDHHS Tribal Youth Suicide Grant Initiative #1U79SM060417-01 was**
10 **received for budget/period from August 1, 2011 through July 31, 2014, in the amount**
11 **of \$1,440,000.00 for annually \$480,000.00; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the total annual grant amount of \$480,000.00 for budget FY 2012 covering August 1,**
13 **2011 to July 31, 2012, has been developed and reflects the current indirect cost rate of**
14 **18.82%; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office, the Health & Human Services Oversight and Budget and Finance**
16 **Committee have reviewed and approved this budget.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 18 **1. Approve the acceptance of the Tribal Youth Suicide Grant Initiative from**
19 **1U79SMO60417-01 DHHS/SAMHSA in the amount of \$1,440,000 with a project**
20 **period of August 1, 2011 to July 30, 2014.**
- 21 **2. Hereby approves and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the FY 2012**
22 **covering August 1, 2011 to July 31, 2012, for the Youth Suicide Prevention Grant**
23 **Initiative and attached budget in the amount of \$480,000.00 for the first year of a**
24 **three year grant; and reflects the current indirect cost rate of 18.82%.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
26 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
27 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
28 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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
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1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
