

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Re-designating KOHN, an Executive Program under the Executive Branch, to Hewel Ñi'oki)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-127**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation), as the licensee, operates KOHN FM as an**  
2 **Executive Program under the Executive Branch with the program designation of**  
3 **KOHN, the call letters of the current station; and**

4 **WHEREAS, KOHN, as an executive program, is complete with a management, programming and**  
5 **production staff (current management); and**

6 **WHEREAS, on October 31, 2011 the Federal Communications Commission granted the Nation an**  
7 **FM Broadcast Station Construction Permit (Authorization) to construct a new radio**  
8 **station at San Lucy, San Lucy District (San Lucy station), subject to the completion of**  
9 **the international notification process pending before the Comision Federal de**  
10 **Telecomunicaciones of the Republic of Mexico; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Authorization includes the waiver of a main studio and permits the operation of**  
12 **the new San Lucy station as a satellite of KOHN to carry the programming originating**  
13 **from KOHN; and**

14 **WHEREAS, upon completion of the new San Lucy station it will be assigned new call letters for**  
15 **station identification; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the current management will continue to operate both stations with existing**  
17 **personnel which necessitates the need to re-designate the program name from its**  
18 **current designation, KOHN, to an appropriate program designation; and**

19 **WHEREAS, in support of the Nation's efforts to preserve and sustain the O'odham language the**  
20 **current management recommends that KOHN be re-designated as Hewel Ñi'oki.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby**  
22 **re-designates KOHN, an executive program under the Executive Branch, to Hewel**  
23 **Ñi'oki.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this re-designation is for program identification only and does not**  
25 **affect nor rescind any prior acts of this council as these actions may relate to the**  
26 **previous designated program, KOHN.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman or any designated official is hereby authorized to**  
28 **direct any changes necessary to comply with this new designation.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
30 **of APRIL, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**  
31 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**  
32 **VI, Section 1 (c)(8) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
33 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
34 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
35 **Stat. 984).**
