

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending award for the Family Violence Prevention and Services Grant from the
U.S. Department of Human Services Administration for Children and Families
FY 2012) Amendment No. 2, Account #300.12.6295)**

RESOLUTION NO. 12-129

1 WHEREAS, prevention of injuries is priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
2 WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence Program within the Department of Health and Human Services
3 Community Health Division, and the Domestic Violence Coalition are working to raise
4 awareness of family violence and continue the development of services for domestic
5 violence victims and their families; and
6 WHEREAS, the Family Violence Prevention budget amendment #1 in the amount of \$123,892.00
7 to match the FY12 awarded amount was approved by Resolution No. 12-013; and
8 WHEREAS, the total budget amount of \$123,892.00 remains unchanged; and
9 WHEREAS, budget amendment #2 has been prepared to create line item 7100 Utilities, to pay for
10 the utility expenses for the Safe House; and
11 WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee
12 of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and
13 adoption.
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
15 and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached FY 2012 Budget
16 Amendment #2 in the amount of \$123,892.00 with created line item 7100 Utility.
17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
18 Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
19 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is
20 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
22 of APRIL, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,594.30 FOR; 186.30
23 AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
24 Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
25 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
26 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
27 Stat. 984).
