

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Senior Services FY 2013 Title VI Part A, Part C 700-13-6220 and Nutrition Service Incentive Program (NSIP) Budgets Covering the Second Year of a Three Year Grant)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-131

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham has operated programs for the Elders of the Nation; and
2 WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Senior Services Division is possible in part with
3 funding from Title VI of the Older Americans Act of 1978 as amended and administered
4 by the Administration of Aging; and
5 WHEREAS, the Senior Services Division is requesting approval for the FY 2013 Title VI Part A, Part
6 C and Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) budgets that will cover the second
7 year of a three year grant that commenced on April 1, 2011 to March 31, 2014;

13 WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of
14 the Legislative Council have reviewed the budgets and recommend its approval and
15 adoption.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
17 approves the Senior Services Division FY2013 Title VI budgets for Part A \$134,330.00,
18 Part C \$46,770.00 and Nutrition Services Incentive (NSIP) \$2,518.00 for the budget
19 period of April 1, 2012 to March 31, 2013 and to utilize the Nation's Resources pending
20 reimbursement from the Grantor for the continuation of the Grant.

21 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby authorizes
22 the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
23 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funding or funding level is
24 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
26 of APRIL, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-
27 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article
28 VI, Section 1(c)(2) & (j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
29 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
30 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
31 Stat. 984).

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
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
