

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services,**  
**Division of Community Health Services, Public Health Preparedness and Response**  
**Bioterrorism (BT) FY12 Budget Amendment No. 1, Account 600.12.6211)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-157**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is concerned with the health, welfare and safety of its**  
2 **members who reside on or near the Tohono O'odham Nation Reservation, including**  
3 **the O'odham in Mexico; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Public Health Preparedness and Response for Bioterrorism is within the charter of the**  
5 **Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Community**  
6 **Health Services; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control award stipulates a 10% match requirement that will be**  
8 **met through cost share of the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP)**  
9 **Coordinator salary with Community Health, which results in a total decrease of**  
10 **\$27,510.87 in lines 6000 Salaries and 6200 Fringe; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement Contract No #ADHS 11-005790 Amendment #2 grant**  
12 **award was reduced to \$65,00.00 for 2011-2012 grant project year; therefore allowing**  
13 **the following modifications to program line items; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Amendment #2 will allow the following lines items to being created; 7220 Mileage GSA,**  
15 **7300 Advertisement, and 7345 Consultant. Also increasing line items; 6500 Tuition and**  
16 **Registration, 6510 Lodging, 6530 Travel Expense, 7005 Supplies Other 7355**  
17 **Professional Services, 7340 Public Relations. And decreasing line items: 7305**  
18 **Insurance, 7110 Communication Expenses, 7075 Fuel, 7000 supplies-Office, 7010**  
19 **Program Supplies, and 9000 Indirect Cost Charges, which adjusts the total amount of**  
20 **the budget to \$65,000 for FY12; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants & Contracts, Executive**  
22 **Office, Health Committee and Budget & Finance Committee of all which recommend**  
23 **for acceptance by the Legislative Council.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 25 **1. Approves the 2012 BT budget Amendment in the amount of \$65,000.00.**
- 26 **2. Authorizes the Nation to meet the 10% match requirement by cost sharing the**  
27 **PHEP Coordinator's salary with Community Health.**
- 28 **3. Authorizes the Nation to obligate and expend funds upon approval of this**  
29 **resolution.**

6 of MAY, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
7 [01] NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,  
8 Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
9 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
10 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
