LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Adopting Amended Enrollment Revocation Hearing Rules)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 12-160

1	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power to "enact laws and ordinances
2	governing the relinquishment and loss of membership" (Constitution of the
3	Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(h)); and
4	WHEREAS, Article IX of the Enrollment Ordinance, Ordinance No. 5-81 (as amended), provides for
5	the loss of membership in the Tohono O'odham Nation on grounds of dual enrollment
6	or when enrollment was based upon incorrect or omitted information; and
7	WHEREAS, the Rules Committee, in consultation with the Legislative Council officers, has
8	developed the "Amended Enrollment Revocation Hearing Rules," as dated for
9	reference "May 2012," which are incorporated by this reference; and
10	WHEREAS, the Amended Enroll ment Revocation Hearing Rules would provide a procedure for the
11	loss of membership based upon dual enrollment or when enrollment was based upon
12	incorrect or omitted information; and
13	WHEREAS, the Rules Committee recommends that the Amended Enrollment Revocation Hearing
14	Rules be adopted.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopts the
16	Amended Enrollment Revocation Hearing Rules as dated for reference "May 2012,"
17	and all Council revocation hearing procedures and rules that were adopted prior to
18	the effective date of this legislative order are repealed.
