

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Senior Services FY 2012 Budget Amendment #2 Account #001-12-6201**  
**an Increase of \$44,880.18)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-164**

1 **WHEREAS, the FY 2012 Division of Senior Services budget was approved by the Tohono O'odham**  
2 **Legislative Council by Resolution No. 11-320 to provide services to the Nation's elder**  
3 **population; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the FY 2012 Senior Services Budget Amendment #2 is prepared to increase the budget**  
5 **from \$501,110.93 to \$545,911.11 a difference of \$44,800.18; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the increase will allow Senior Services to accommodate and provide services and a**  
7 **nutritious meal to eligible Elder clients at the newly established congregate meal sites,**  
8 **in Gu Vo and at Management of Health (MOH); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the increase will establish new line items: 7100-Utilities; 7110-Communications; 7355-**  
10 **Professional Services and 7060-Food and increase funds in line items: 7305-Insurance;**  
11 **7005-Supplies Office Equipment and 7680-Special Activities; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and Budget and Finance Committee of the**  
13 **Legislative Council have reviewed this budget amendment #2 and recommend its**  
14 **approval and adoption.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
16 **approves the Senior Services FY 2012 budget amendment #2 to increase the budget**  
17 **from \$501,110.93 to \$545,911.11 an increase of \$44,880.18 and that the increase is**  
18 **recurring funds to support the additional congregate meal sites. To be appropriated**  
19 **from Surplus Funds.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**  
21 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
22 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level of this**  
23 **budget is submitted for further approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
25 **of MAY, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**  
27 **Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**  
28 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
29 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
