19	membership requirement or requirements which the Council found th

22	the Enrollment Committee's recommendations and approves the applications fo
23	enrollment or adoption that are identified in the June 2012 Membership Application

25	requirement or, for adoption, the degree of Papago-Tohono O'odham Indian blood fo
