# **RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL** (Approving Agreement with New Magma Irrigation and Drainage District)

		(1. The base of a them Netter is entitled to receive a total of 66,000 acre-feet of Central
1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation is entitled to receive a total of 66,000 acre-feet of Central
2		Arizona Project ("CAP") water per year; and
3	WHEREAS,	under the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act, as amended ("SAWRSA"),
4		Title III of Public Law 108-451, the Nation is authorized to utilize its CAP water either
5		on reservation or off reservation; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Nation has negotiated an agreement (the "Agreement") with the New Magma
7		Irrigation and Drainage District ("NMIDD"), which is designated as a groundwater
8		savings facility under Arizona law, to deliver a portion of the Nation's CAP entitlement
9		to NMIDD as "in-lieu water"; and
10	WHEREAS,	NMIDD is located in the Phoenix Active Management Area; and
11	WHEREAS,	under the proposed Agreement, the Nation will be paid by NMIDD for the water and
12		will also accumulate marketable long-term storage credits through the use by NMIDD
13		of the Nation's CAP water instead of NMIDD pumping and using groundwater within
14		the irrigation district itself; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Agreement is for less than one year and will terminate on December 31, 2012, at
16		which time an additional one year agreement can be considered, but is not required;
17		and
18	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 12-137 the Legislative Council authorized the Chairman of the
19		Nation to apply for a permit from the Arizona Department of Water Resources, which
20		will authorize the Nation to store its water at the NMIDD groundwater savings facility;
21		and
22	WHEREAS,	in Section 11 of the Agreement, the Nation has agreed to provide a limited waiver of
23		sovereign immunity to allow for dispute resolution in any court of competent
24		jurisdiction, not to include Arizona state courts, which waiver is limited to declaratory
25	Ť	and injunctive relief to enforce the Agreement but does not include a waiver of any
26		claims for money damages, attorney's fees, court costs or any other costs, damages,
27		remedy, or claims of any other kind; and
28	WHEREAS	, the Water Resources and the Domestic Affairs Committees have reviewed the
29		Agreement and recommend approval by the Legislative Council.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves	
2	the Agreement Between New Magma Irrigation and Drainage District and the Tohono	
3	O'odham Nation Providing for the Delivery of In-lieu Water for Water Storage at a	
4	Groundwater Savings Facility and hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to	
5	execute the Agreement and any additional documentation reasonably necessary to	
6	implement the intent of the Agreement, provided that any extensions of the Agreement	
7	beyond December 31, 2012 shall require review and approval by the Legislative	
8	Council.	
9	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves a limited	
10	waiver of the Nation's sovereign immunity to allow disputes arising between the	
11	parties with respect to this Agreement or the annual scheduling agreement to be	
12	resolved in any court of competent jurisdiction, not to include Arizona state courts,	
13	and limits the waiver to declaratory and injunctive relief to enforce the Agreement but	
14	does not waive its sovereign immunity with respect to any claims for money damages,	
15	attorney's fees, court costs or any other costs, damages, remedy, or claims of any other	
16	kind.
