

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) Sexual Assault grant
under the Grant to Indian Tribal Governments Program for FY 2013)**

RESOLUTION NO. 12-218

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Management of Health Division**
2 **coordinates services provision for its ten divisions; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services was granted \$900,000.00, for a three**
4 **year grant for project period 10/01/09 09/30/12; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Violence Against Women program (OVW) sexual assault had a delayed start due to**
6 **staff turnover and hiring of permanent staffing which caused for a large amount of**
7 **unobligated funds; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation will be requesting a no cost extension for FY2013; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants Contracts, Executive Office,**
10 **Health Committee and Budget & Finance Committee of all which recommend for**
11 **acceptance by the Legislative Council.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
13 **Office of Violence Against Women (OVW) sexual assault Fiscal Year 2013 Budget**
14 **estimated at \$300,000.00 pending approval of a no cost extension from the funding**
15 **agency and to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement from the Grantor**
16 **for the continuation of the Grant. Should the Office of Violence Against Women Grant**
17 **not receive further funding the Tohono Nation will not be obligated to utilize the**
18 **Nation's resources beyond the final year.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**
21 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28TH Day**
24 **of JUNE, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**
26 **Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
27 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
