

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Continuation award for the Family Violence Prevention and Services
Grant from the U.S. Department of Human Services Administration for Children
and Families Account # 300-13-6295 FY2013)**

RESOLUTION NO. 12-221

1 **WHEREAS, prevention of injuries is priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
2 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence Program within the Department of Health and Human**
3 **Services-Division of Community Health Services, and with collaboration with the**
4 **Domestic Violence Coalition, are working to raise awareness of family violence and**
5 **continue the development of services for domestic violence victims and their families;**
6 **and**
7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services has continually**
8 **received a Family Violence Prevention and Services State Grant award averaging a**
9 **total of \$124,000.00; and**
10 **WHEREAS, the Administration for Children and Families approves continued expenditures in two**
11 **year increments, therefore the period would be from October 1, 2011, through**
12 **September 30, 2013, of this grant in the estimated amount of \$124,000.00; and**
13 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**
14 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
15 **adoption.**
16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
17 **and approves the Family Violence Prevention and Services Budget effective 10/01/2011**
18 **and ending 09/30/2013 and authorizes the expenditure of funds in the amount of**
19 **\$124,000.00 and to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement from the**
20 **Grantor for the continuation of the Grant.**
21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
22 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
23 **attached hereto, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level**
24 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
25 **Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28TH Day**
27 **of JUNE, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**
29 **Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


