5	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Veterans Affairs Office is operating a 1999 Chevrolet Suburban
6	vehicle with an excess of 175,000 miles; and
7	WHEREAS, the vehicle currently assigned to Veterans Affairs is costing more each year to
8	maintain and operate; and
9	WHEREAS, the rising costs of fuel and related supplies are detrimental to the Mission and
10	Purpose of the Veterans Affairs Office and their budget.
11	WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee and the Budget and Finance
12	Committee of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its
13	approval and adoption.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
15	the FY 2013 Supplemental Budget for one time funding of the Tohono O'odham
16	Veterans Affairs Office for the purchase of two (2) vehicles in the amount of \$60,000.
17	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
18	Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as
19	attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is
20	submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
