1	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures to
2	regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards
3	and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,
4	Section 1(a)); and
5	WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council with
6	the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative Rules, Article
7	I, Section 1(D)(1)); and
8	WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules also provide that each legislative session "shall commence at $9:00$
9	a.m." (Article I, Section 1(B)(4)); and
10	WHEREAS, the district chairs have requested that the Legislative Council conduct a special
11	session on July 6, 2012 beginning at 8:30 a.m. for a constitutional workshop with
12	district officials, Nation's officials, and Native Nations Institute.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council sets a special
14	session on July ${f 6,2012}$ for a constitutional workshop in Legislative Council chambers,
15	and, notwithstanding Article I, Section 1(B)(4) of the Legislative Rules, the special
16	session shall commence at 8:30 a.m.
17	BE IT FINALLY ORDERED that the attendance and quorum provisions of the Legislative Rules shall
18	apply to the July $6,2012$ special session, but the remaining provisions of the Legislative Rules shall
19	be suspended.
