

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Amendment No. 2 to the FY 2012 638 Law Enforcement budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-270

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation contracts its own Law Enforcement, Ranger and**
2 **Corrections Programs under the 638 BIA Master Contract; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) has amended the 638 Law**
4 **Enforcement base budget; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has increased line items 7015 Uniforms, 7045 Animal Supplies, 7230**
6 **Lease/Rentals, 7355 Professional Service, and 7500 Major Capital; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, the TONPD has decreased line item 7440 Computer Maintenance and move that**
8 **amount into another line item; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, Creating new line items 7010 Program Supplies; 7100 Utilities; 7006 Computer Cost;**
10 **7040 Ammunition; 7055 Trained Animals and 7420 Repair & Maintenance of Building;**
11 **and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, budget amendment No. 2 shall also increase the Indirect Cost (IDC) to reflect the**
13 **approved IDC rate \$18.82% from 16.82% in accordance to the Tohono O'odham Nations**
14 **increase to the IDC amount changing the amount; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, the FY 2012 638 Law Enforcement Budget Amendment No. 2 has been reviewed by the**
16 **budget office, Grants & Contracts, Executive, Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance**
17 **Committee of the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its**
18 **approval and adoption.**
- 19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
20 **approves and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 2 as follows:**
- 21 **1) Received carry over savings but will only utilize a portion of the carryover savings**
22 **and remaining amount will be utilized at another date has been added to the FY**
23 **2012 638 Law Enforcement budget.**
 - 24 **2) Increased line items 7015 Uniforms, 7045 Animal Supplies, 7230 Lease/Rental,**
25 **7355 Professional Services, and 7500 Major Capital.**
 - 26 **3) Decreased line item 7440 Computer Maintenance by \$25,000.00 to be added into**
27 **another line item.**
 - 28 **4) Creating new line items 7010 Program Supplies, 7100 Utilities, 7006 Computer**
29 **Cost, 7040 Ammunition, 7055 Trained Animals, and 7420 Repair & Maintenance**
30 **of Building.**


5) Changing Indirect Cost to reflect the approved rate of 18.82% from 16.82%

6) Changing the total budget amount from \$5,069,803.82 to \$5,433,939.74

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day of JULY, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
