

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2012 Budget Amendment No. 1 for the Department of Justice, Office
of Justice Programs, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention,
Youth Mentoring Program Grant No. 2011-TY-FX-0010)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-272

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation applied for and was awarded the Department of Justice**
2 **(DOJ) Office of Justice Program (OJP) Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency**
3 **Prevention (OJJDP) Youth Mentoring Program (YMP) Grant; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (TOLC) enacted TOLC Resolution No. 11-541**
5 **accepted the YMP grant award and approved an FY 2012 Budget; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, on December 2, 2011 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacted TOLC**
7 **Resolution No. 11-560 approving the Tohono O'odham Nation Executive, Judicial and**
8 **Legislative Tri Branch FY 2012 Tohono O'odham Nation Pay Plan effective October 1,**
9 **2011 and TOLC Resolution No. 11-561 approving a 6.33% Wage Adjustment for all**
10 **employees and Full-Time Officials of the Nation's Executive, Legislative and Judicial**
11 **Branch in FY 2012; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Pay Plan and wage adjustment has impacted the**
13 **previously approved grant budget from the Department of Justice/Bureau of Justice**
14 **Programs and therefore required a Grant Adjustment Notice to be filed for the**
15 **approval of the increased salaries for the Program Manager and Administrative**
16 **Assistant; and**
- 17 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has amended the approved FY 2012 Budget to reflect the**
18 **increase in salary and fringe benefits and reduced the Operational Expense line items**
19 **necessary to meet the increases; and**
- 20 **WHEREAS, line item 6020 Other Compensation was removed from the FY 12 budget which is not**
21 **allowed per grant guidance, and further decreased line item 6200 Fringe Benefits; and**
- 22 **WHEREAS, the Indirect Cost has increased and the budget total of \$159,887.91 does not change;**
23 **and**
- 24 **WHEREAS, the FY 12 Budget Amendment No. 1 has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants &**
25 **Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and the Budget & Finance**
26 **Committee, of all which recommend acceptance by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
27 **Council.**
- 28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
29 **approves the FY 12 Budget Amendment No. 1 for the DOJ/OJP/OJJP Youth Mentoring**



4 Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
5 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be
6 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

7 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day
8 of JULY, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
9 -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3)
10 & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
11 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
12 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
13 Stat. 984).


