

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendments #1 FY 2012 for the One Stop Division of the Education
Department with the Arizona Department of Economic Security)**

RESOLUTION NO. 12-273

1 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security entered into an intergovernmental**
2 **agreement (IGA) with the Tohono O'odham Nation to provide the Nation with funds for**
3 **specific Workforce Investment Act (WIA) employment and training programs operated**
4 **by the Education Department's One Stop Division; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the original IGA was approved by TOLC resolution #11-182 and amendment # 1 to the**
6 **IGA was approved by TOLC resolution 11-521 to allocate funds to the Nation for FY 2012**
7 **in the amount of \$243,436.00 for the period beginning April 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013;**

9 **WHEREAS, the One Stop Division will amend the FY 12 budgets to reflect the awarded allocations**
10 **per IGA amendment #1 identified in the table below:**

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1 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee**
2 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
3 **adoption.**

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
5 **approve and authorize the expenditure of the FY 2011 State Budget Amendments #1**
6 **for the Education Department – One Stop Division effective April 1, 2010 to June 30,**
7 **2013 in the amount of \$243,436.00 with any FY12 balances to be carried forward into**
8 **FY13.**

9 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves:**

19 **Tuition and Registration, 6510 Lodging, 6530 Travel Expense, 7680 Special**
20 **Activities, 9000 Indirect Costs.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Chairperson**
22 **and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as attached, provided**
23 **that any amendment affecting the funds or funding level shall be submitted for**
24 **further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
26 **of JULY, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3)**
28 **& (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**

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




