

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Adult Protective Services FY2012 Budget Amendment #2,
Account: 001-12-6030)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-289

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the Division of Adult Protective**
2 **Service FY 2012 budget by Resolution #11-320 passed on July 22, 2011, to provide**
3 **services to abused, neglected and exploited elders and vulnerable adults; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, the FY 2012 budget did not include line items necessary to provide certain program**
5 **services; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the attached Budget Amendment #2 has been prepared to decrease line items 6500**
7 **Tuition and Registration, 6510 Lodging, 6530 Travel Expense, 7010 Program Supplies,**
8 **7020 Kitchen Supplies, 7060 Food, 7230 Lease/Rentals, 7400 RM Equipment, 7610**
9 **Clothing Allowance, and 7665 Client Support; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, increase line items 7100 Utilities, 7110 Communication Expense, 7075 Fuel, 7000**
11 **Supplies Office, 7210 Dues and Subscriptions; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, creating new line items, 7310 Employee Security Clearances, 7340 Public Relations and**
13 **7650 Adult Custodial Care; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, there is no change in the total approved budget of \$1,287,434.66; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**
16 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget amendment and recommend its**
17 **approval and adoption.**
- 18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
19 **approves Adult Protective Services FY2012 Budget Amendment #2:**
- 20 **1. Decreasing line items 6500 Tuition and Registration, 6510 Lodging, 6530 Travel**
21 **Expense, 7010 Program Supplies, 7020 Kitchen Supplies, 7230 Lease/Rentals, 7400**
22 **RM Equipment, 7060 Food, 7610 Clothing Allowance, and 7665 Client Support.**
 - 23 **2. Increasing line items 7100 Utilities, 7110 Communication Expense, 7075 Fuel, 7000**
24 **Supplies Office and 7210 Dues and Subscriptions.**
 - 25 **3. Creating three new line items, 7310 Employee Security Clearances, 7340 Public**
26 **Relations and 7650 Adult Custodial Care.**
 - 27 **4. There will be no change in approved budget total amount of \$1,287,434.66.**
- 28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
29 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
30 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funding or funding level is**
31 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
