11		reauthorizes funds for this project under Sub-grantee Agreement No. 10-AZDOHS-
12		OPSG-777418-03; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Sub-grantee Agreement No.10-AZDOHS-OPSG-777418-03hasbeenreviewedby the
14		Office of the Attorney General; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Arizona Department of Homeland Security Grant Program Operation Stone

17	WHEREAS,	the FY 2012 Budget Amendment #2 has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants &
