## LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Holding August 10, 2012 Legislative Council Session at Tumacacori National Historical Park in Tumacacori, Arizona)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 12-311

1	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures to
2	regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards
3	and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,
4	Section 1(a)); and
5	WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
6	Council, as amended, provides that "[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be held at
7	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono O'odham
8	Nation, with the following exceptions[a] majority of all the legislative representatives
9	may vote to hold a session in some location other than the chambers located at Sells.";

11	WHEREAS, the Legislative Cultural Preservation Committee has recommended that the
12	Legislative Council tour the Tumacacori National Historical Park and historical sites
13	located in Tumacacori, Arizona during the August 10, 2012 general session with roll
14	call beginning at 9 a.m.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the August 10,
16	2012 general session be held at Tumacacori National Historical Park and historical
17	sites located at Tumacacori, Arizona with roll call beginning at 9:00 a.m.
