

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting September 18, 2012 Special Session to Tour the CAP Underground Storage Facilities
at the Tucson Water Hayden-Udall Water Treatment Facility and Arroyos Project)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 12-312

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power “to establish rules and procedures to**
2 **regulate all meetings of the Tohono O’odham Council, standing committees, boards**
3 **and special committees.” (Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council vests the Council with**
6 **the authority to “by majority vote, call for a special session” (Legislative Rules of the**
7 **Tohono O’odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2.,(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O’odham Legislative**
9 **Council, as amended, provides that “[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be held at**
10 **the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono O’odham**
11 **Nation, with the following exceptions. . . [a] majority of all the legislative**
12 **representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other than the chambers**
13 **located at Sells.”; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee has requested a special session on September 18,**
15 **2012 for the Legislative Council to tour the CAP underground storage facilities at the**
16 **Tucson Water Hayden-Udall Water Treatment Facility and Arroyos Project with roll**
17 **call beginning at 9 a.m.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it sets a**
19 **special session on September 18, 2012 for the Legislative Council to tour the CAP**
20 **underground storage facilities at the Tucson Water Hayden-Udall Water Treatment**
21 **Facility and Arroyos Project with roll call beginning at 9 a.m.**

22 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council on the 06TH day of**
23 **AUGUST, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,680.25 FOR; 100.35**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
25 **VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O’odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**
