

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Arizona Boxing Commission and Tohono O'odham Nation
Intergovernmental Agreement)**

RESOLUTION NO. 12-328

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to provide laws "to**
2 **promote, protect and provide for public health" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
3 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is further vested with the power to "consult, negotiate and**
5 **conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with**
6 **Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their departments,**
7 **agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all**
8 **matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution of the**
9 **Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

10 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-599, as amended by Resolution No. 02-604, the Legislative Council**
11 **adopted Ordinance No. 02-01, the "Ordinance for the Regulation of Professional**
12 **Boxing Matches within the Tohono O'odham Nation," to govern and regulate**
13 **professional boxing matches on the Nation and to establish health and safety**
14 **standards for the protection of boxers and participants, and authorized the**
15 **Chairperson of the Nation to negotiate an intergovernmental agreement to allow the**
16 **Arizona State Boxing Commission to carry out the regulation of professional boxing**
17 **matches on the Nation's lands on the Nation's behalf; and**

18 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 08-512, the Legislative Council repealed Ordinance No. 02-01 and**
19 **adopted and codified Tohono O'odham Code Title 17, Chapter 5, "Boxing and Unarmed**
20 **Combat" to govern and regulate "mixed martial arts" and "unarmed combat"**
21 **competitions as well as professional boxing matches, and to establish health and**
22 **safety standards for the protection of contestants; and authorized the Chairperson of**
23 **the Nation to negotiate an intergovernmental agreement to allow the Arizona State**
24 **Boxing Commission to carry out the regulation of such contests on the Nation's lands**
25 **on the Nation's behalf; and**

26 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise, in coordination with the Office of Attorney**
27 **General, recommends that the Nation enter into a new intergovernmental agreement**
28 **on terms beneficial to the Nation and the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise; and**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Commerce Committee has reviewed, and recommends that the Nation**
2 **enter into, the Arizona Boxing and Mixed Martial Arts Commission and Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation Intergovernmental Agreement ("Intergovernmental Agreement")**
4 **substantially in the form attached hereto; and**

5 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Nation to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement.**
6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
7 **approves the Intergovernmental Agreement.**


8 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes and**
9 **directs the Chairman of the Nation to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement,**
10 **and to take all other actions consistent with this Resolution that are necessary to**
11 **achieve full execution of the Intergovernmental Agreement.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
13 **of AUGUST, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
14 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
15 **1 (c)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
16 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
17 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
18 **Stat. 984).**


