## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Authorizing and Accepting the Federal Charter of Incorporation for 4th Millennium Incorporated)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-333

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "to provide for,
2		appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers of
3		committees, boards, officers and agents; to establish and regulate subordinate
4		organizations for business purposes." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
5		Article VI, Section 1(b)); and
6	WHEREAS,	Federally Chartered Corporations under Section 17 of the Indian Reorganization Act
7	!	("Section 17 corporations") are legal entities that are wholly-owned by the tribe but
8		conduct  and  manage  business  activities  separate  from  the  tribal  government,  may  be
9		empowered to purchase, hold, operate, manage and dispose of real and personal
10		property; and they enjoy the same privileges and immunities as an Indian tribe for
11		$federal\ income\ tax\ purposes\ including\ the\ is suance\ of\ tax\ exempt\ debt, and\ may\ assert$
12		or waive sovereign immunity; and
13	WHEREAS,	Section 17 corporations may be authorized to enter into contracts or leases,
14		mortgages or otherwise encumber tribal lands, including trust and restricted lands
15		within the reservation, for a 25 year period without the Bureau of Indian Affairs
16		approval under 25 U.S.C. § 81; and
17	WHEREAS,	a Section 17 corporation would be a beneficial business entity for the Nation and will
18		promote  the  best  interests, general  welfare  and  economic  development  of  the  Nation;
19		and
20	WHEREAS,	the Planning and Economic Development Department has consulted with and plans
21		to work in cooperation with the Economic Development Authority in the development
22		of projects housed under the Section 17 corporation; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Nation wishes to create a Section 17 corporation; and
24	WHEREAS,	Resolution No. 11-519 authorized the Planning and Economic Development
25		Department to prepare a corporate charter and other legally required documents to
26		form a Section 17 corporation; and
27	WHEREAS,	the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared a corporate
28		charter for the Section 17 corporation, which will be called 4th Millennium
29		Incorporated; and

1	WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee, Agricultural & Natural Resource Committee, and the Rule
2	Committee each recommend the creation of a Section 17 corporation, which will be
3	called 4 <sup>th</sup> Millennium Incorporated.
4	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
5	approves the proposed corporate Charter for 4 <sup>th</sup> Millennium Incorporated attached
6	hereto as Exhibit A.
7	NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the
8	Chairman, or any designated official, to submit the Charter of 4 <sup>th</sup> Millenniun
9	Incorporated to the Secretary of the Interior on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation
10	and is further authorized and directed to take such other steps and to execute and
11	deliver to the Department of the Interior such other agreements and documents as
12	may be appropriate or required to implement the foregoing directive and to
13	accomplish, complete and provide for the approval of the formation of the Section 1.
14	Corporation.
15	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby requests the Secretary of the
16	Interior, or the Secretary's designee, to review and approve expeditiously the
17	proposed corporate Charter consistent with the requirements of 25 U.S.C. § 477.
