

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement GRA-RC026-13-0532-01 and
Budget with Arizona Early Childhood Development and Health Board
(First Things First) and the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 12-351

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes and prioritizes the importance of Health,**
2 **Education and General Well-being of children of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the First Things First Initiative was passed by Arizona Voters in 2006 via proposition**
4 **203 which increases the quality and access to Early Childhood Programs that will**
5 **ensure all Arizona children enter school healthy and ready to learn; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes specific areas of need in the Division of Special**
7 **Needs Program of the Nation's Department of Health and Human Services for which**
8 **funding may be allocated to the Nation through the proposed Intergovernmental**
9 **Agreement with the First Things First organization; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the First Things First Intergovernmental Agreement has awarded the Nation \$200,000**
11 **for the period beginning July 1, 2012 and renewable for an additional two years based**
12 **on performance and availability of funds; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Grants & Contracts Office, Executive Office, the Health and Human Services and**
14 **Domestic Affairs Committees of the Legislative Council have reviewed the First Things**
15 **First Intergovernmental Agreement GRA-RC026-13-0532-01, and recommend it's**
16 **approval by the Legislative Council; and**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
18 **and authorizes the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Nation and First Things First and approves the award allocation in the amount of**
20 **\$200,000 beginning July 1, 2012 and renewable for two additional years based on**
21 **performance and availability of funds.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
23 **Chairman and any designated official execute the First Things First**
24 **Intergovernmental Agreement GRA-RC026-13-0532-01, and expend and administer the**
25 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding**
26 **level is submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
27 **Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
29 **of SEPTEMBER, 2012 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [02]ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
31 **VI, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
32 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
33 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
